- Helping deliver events 'on stand' activities, such as next box building, children's educational activities.
- Event planning and coordination including setting up and clearing away afterwards.
- Participating in event reviews and providing constructive feedback.

The skills you need

• The most important skill will be your people skills, we aren't looking for wildlife expertise of knowledge of the RSPB. We are looking for someone who enjoys meeting new people and is a confident communicator.

• It will help if you have a good attention to detail and are quite organised to help ensure events and activities are carried out safely.

 have the opportunity to make new friends and spend time outdoors. You
 will get to meet loads of new people in this role, enjoying conversation
 and helping people have a great interaction with the RSPB.
